



Responsibilities After a Homelessness Death

Understanding the essential steps for housing providers following a death in their premises.

01

Notification

Assign a person to promptly inform and document the occurrence of the death.

02

Information Collection

Gather necessary details about the deceased to accurately complete the reporting form and facilitate the review process.

03

Internal Review

Conduct a thorough review of the information, addressing key questions and identifying lessons to enhance future practices.

04

Submission

Submit the finalised reporting form to Brent council for further processing and record-keeping.

05

Continuous Improvement

Regularly assess the process to improve efficiency and ensure compliance with housing provider responsibilities.
