HOW TO REGISTER ON THE ME LEARNING WEBSITE

- 1) Make sure you have access to your email before you register
- 2) Type in this address or click on link: <https://app.melearning.co.uk/auth/validate-key?registerKey=RGHTNDZY>
- 3) Enter all of your details.
- 4) Enter the correct information in all of the fields using the drop-down arrow to select.
- 5) Click '**Sign up**'
- 7) You will then receive an email with your username and password.
- 8) Once registration is complete you will be able to log on to complete courses in future with your email address and password.
- 9) On the home screen select '**Browse Courses**' (this will show you all courses available)
- 10) On the right of the course, you wish to complete click '**View**'
- 11) Complete equal opportunities form
- 12) Enrolment details – select '**enrol**'
