What's a LADO?

The Local Authority Designated Officer

What does the LADO do?

- Manages allegations* made against every adult who works with children in Bromley, both paid and unpaid.
- Assesses and reviews the referrals and decides if an Allegation Against Staff and Volunteers (ASV) meeting is required
- Organises, investigates and chairs the ASV
- Manages and has oversight of all cases referred
- Provides advice and guidance to employers and voluntary organisations
- Liaises with the police and other agencies, such as Ofsted, Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS), NHS England and the Football Association (FA)
- Jointly investigates cases involving a criminal offence with the police.
- Monitors the progress of cases to ensure they are dealt with fairly, consistently and quickly
