You can access safeguarding training courses on Me Learning's easy-to-use website – ideal as a refresher or as an induction for new staff and as a supplement to other types of learning.

These courses are aimed at professionals and volunteers who work or have contact with children, young people and their families and/or adults at risk.

Most courses take between 60 to 90 minutes to complete – but you can dip in and out multiple times and it will remember where you left off. You can log in at work or at home.
