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WELCOME TO THE BROMLEY SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN PARTNERSHIP

What you knew as the Bromley Safeguarding Children Board will change on 1st September 2019 in response to the Children and Social Work Act 2017 and Working Together 2018 which replaces all Local Safeguarding Children Boards (LSCBs) across the country with new local multi-agency safeguarding partnership arrangements.

Our safeguarding partnership arrangements have been improved to form the new Bromley Safeguarding Children Partnership (BSCP) and its sub-groups.

You will see our new logo and branding start to appear on our policies and procedures as they are updated. We also have a new email address and Twitter handle– see 'Contact' on page 2.

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WHAT'S CHANGED?

The safeguarding partnership will now be held accountable by the new Safeguarding Children's Partnership Executive (BSCPE) which is formed of the three statutory Safeguarding Partners: the police; the local authority; and the Clinical Commissioning Group. It will meet at least twice a year.

The main Partnership Board and each refreshed subgroup will continue to meet four times a year. We continue to link to all the other relevant strategic groups and boards in Bromley. See structure/governance diagram on page 3.

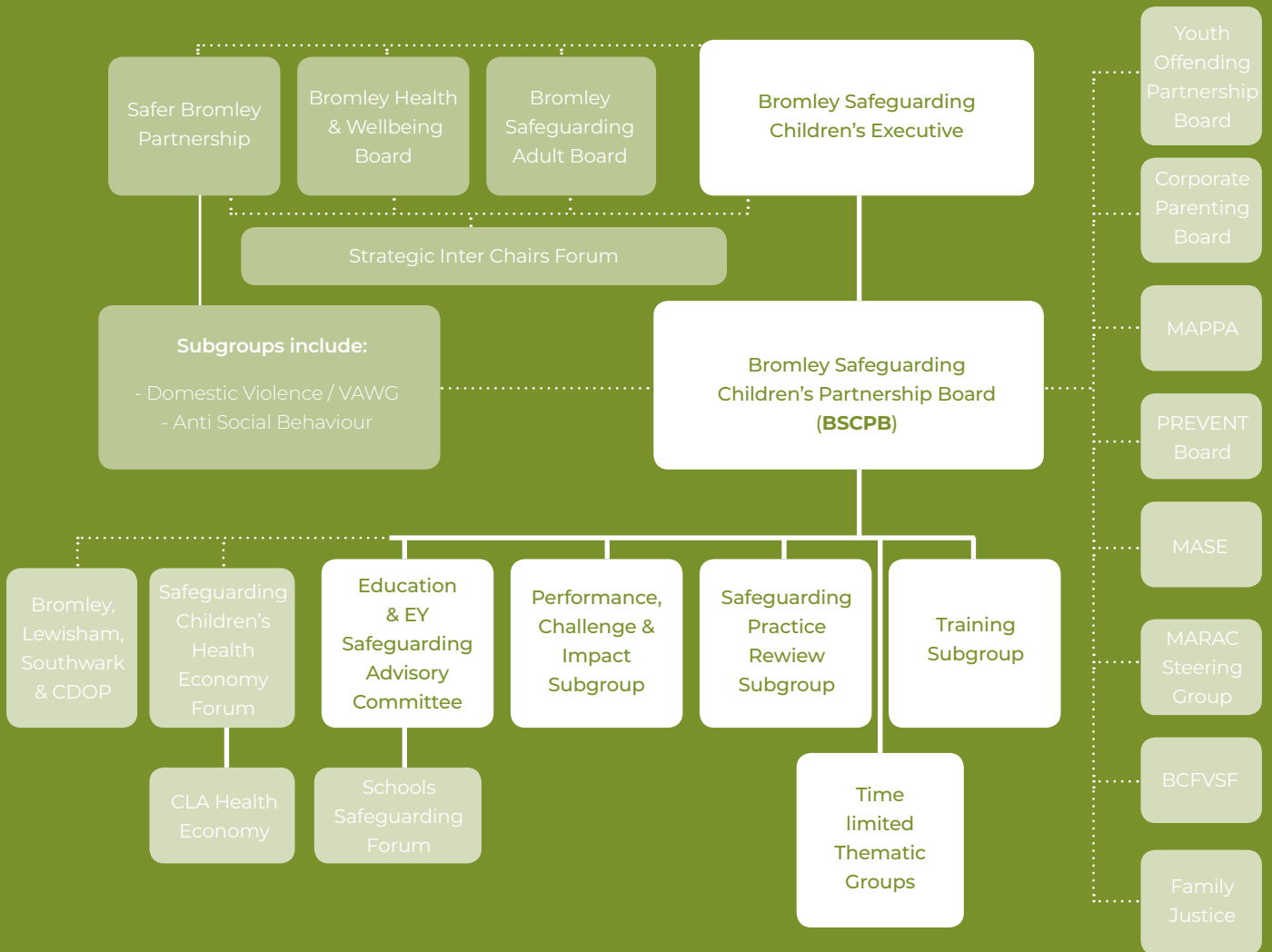

WHAT'S THE SAME?

Our passion and commitment to safeguard the children and young people of Bromley. Bromley has made its new arrangements mindful of the fact that the BSCB was functioning well and had been endorsed as such by Ofsted in November 2018. Given this endorsement, We have made no changes to arrangements simply for change's sake. We will retain our independent chair, Jim Gamble, who will continue as our independent chair of the BSCP.

Our website address is unchanged www.bromleysafeguarding.org as is our phone number and address.

Our policies and procedures remain in place so continue to use the Threshold of Needs Guidance, Escalation Policy, Neglect Strategy, Social Media policies and all the others on our website, as usual. As each one is refreshed and updated then we will republish with the new branding.

Our **multi-agency training programme** was recommissioned in November 2018 and is live. Our **online learning** modules are available to everyone in Bromley for free. There are 19 courses available covering FGM, Forced Marriage, Safeguarding Children levels 1 and 2, Gangs, Modern Day Slavery, Autism Awareness and many more. They are highly rated and take up is very high.

Visit our **Training Programme** webpage for information on classroom based training sessions relevant to those working with children and young people.

In the coming months there are training sessions on Domestic Violence, Child Sexual Exploitation (delivered by the Atlas team), Early Help, Professional Curiosity, Parental Mental Ill-Health, Complex Neglect, Managing Allegations Against Professionals, Use of Chronologies and the CAF as well as Group 3 and the Group 4/5 courses.
