NEW: North West London [NWL] eCDOP from 26.09.19:

Following national changes to the Child Death Review process and related statutory requirementsⁱ, we hope you are already aware that the current separate eCDOP platforms in place across NW London are merging to form one NWL eCDOP. The 8 London boroughs involved in this new NWLⁱⁱ Child Death Review Service are listed in the header above, together with their linked Clinical Commissioning Groups.

Existing CDOP systems will continue to receive child death notifications and undertake CDOP reviews, as now. Please contact your setting/ agency safeguarding lead for further information or contact your CCG's Designated staff for child death.

1. **From Thursday 26th September 2019**, the NWL eCDOP merger means that you will no longer be able to access your local eCDOP url and you will be re-directed.
2. **Your login will transfer to this NW London eCDOP and you will be able to submit information, as you do now.** You will still be able to contact your local CDOP Administrator.
3. **All new Form A child death notifications for NW London** must be sent via www.ecdop.co.uk/NWLondon. **NOTE: you do not require an eCDOP login to submit a Form A.**
4. **All new Form B requests** will include a link back to this new NWL eCDOP url.
5. Links included in emails sent out before 26.09.19, including Form B requests, and any draft Form Bs you are working on, will no longer function. Instead **eCDOP will issue a new email automatically to everyone who has an outstanding Form B request with the correct new links.**
6. All open cases across all 8 NW London boroughs will transfer across automatically to the NW London eCDOP: www.ecdop.co.uk/NWLondon .
7. This new link has been widely circulated amongst local providers/ notifiers, but we ask for your help in reminding colleagues within your agency and setting please.

NOTE: Emails to the old local eCDOP url's will be re-directed to the new NWL site for a period of time.

Reminder: use www.ecdop.co.uk/NWLondon from 26th September 2019, please



Please respond to all eCDOP requests in a timely manner so that any learning may be shared as speedily as possible to help prevent future deaths.

During Autumn 2019 staff will be recruited to a new NWL CDR Team, and further information will be provided closer to when that Team starts operating.

Meanwhile, this eCDOP merger will take place before the new CDR Team goes live.
